4	Stage	The occupier shall apply to the Chief Inspector for such approvals.
5	SLA/ Number of Days	(v) 15 working days for non-hazardous factories; and (vi) 30 working days for hazardous and MAH factories;
6	Documents Required	(i) Resolution for declaration of occupier;
7	Procedure for getting license	<p>Step-1 k) The applicant shall open the Online Single Window Portal using the address (www.niveshmitra.up.nic.in) l) Register in Online portal using their personal Details and Contact Details and login into the portal.</p> <p>Step-2 After logging into the web portal, the applicant shall fill the common application form and add a unit and then shall need to click on Amendment for change in number of workers and power under the factories act 1948</p> <p>Step-3 Then click on fill form for Amendment for change in number of workers and power under the factories act 1948 After completing all entries of the application, click on calculate fee and submit the form. And then click on pay consolidated fee and proceed for payment.</p> <p>Step-4 Departmental officer shall scrutinize the application and dispose it.</p>
